Catch22 is a social business who has been asked by your local authority to independently support children and young people who have been reported missing from home or care.

How does this happen?

The local police will do a safe and well check, then provide Catch22 with information to say your child is now at home.

A Catch22 Case Worker from the service will then contact you to complete a return home interview with your child.

Can you be there?

Yes, of course you can. We would also like to talk to your child alone at some point if they and/or you feel that is appropriate.

Can we help you as parents and carers?

Yes, we can. If you are experiencing any difficulties as a parent or family and feel you need support we can help you to access other services for ongoing help and advice.

What can we do to help your child?

If they are taking risks and feel that they want ongoing support, a Catch22 Case Worker can talk to your child about seeing them weekly until they feel that the problem has been resolved.

Who do we share information with?

If there is information that may help to keep your child or other children safe we may share it with the police and social care - but everything else is confidential to Catch22.
